Small mammal diversity in Sundaland

Abstract: Sundaland, a biogeographical region in Southeast Asia, has complex topography and geological history, which has likely shaped small mammal diversification. Using genetic and ecological data from both modern and museum specimens, I investigated patterns of mammal diversity and evolution across this region. In this talk, I will discuss diversity patterns in mountains and islands and explore the role of genetics in understanding them.
